Double Vision and Amy Lewis

What can shimmying sea lions and disembodied heads possibly have in common? Perhaps fodder for a wacky acid flashback? A ghastly nightmare? Or maybe an enchanting evening

of dance, video, and aural delight performed by intermedia group Double Vision and choreographer Amy Lewis. For two nights (the first being a part of Bay Area National Dance Week), Double Vision and Lewis look to multimedia approaches, stylistic disciplines, and extractions of mathematical and science formulas to achieve a cunning slab of performance art. Double Vision premieres "Fog Is Not Ghost" and restagings of "... As If by Falling" and "Disembodied Head, No. 4." Lewis draws most of her choreography from musical and artistic theories and screens three pieces, including one inspired by Kandinsky's theories of how color affects the spiritual body.
